They provide immediate on-the-scene care as the patient is transported to a medical center. EMT's complete one to two years training at a community college or technical school. There they learn everything from basic first aid and CPR to how to deliver babies and administer medicines. Saving lives is often part of a day's work for emergency medical technicians.
